1. Definitions
 For the purposes of this Agreement, "Event" means the Powerama Customs Winter Custom Car & Bike Show scheduled for February 19 - 21, 2027, including all set-up and tear-down periods. "Promoter" means Powerama Customs, its owners, officers, employees, contractors, agents, successors, and assigns. "Facility" means the Greene County Expo Center & Fairgrounds, the Greene County Agricultural Society, and their respective officers, directors, agents, and employees. "Exhibitor" means the individual or entity whose name appears on the registration form, together with its employees, representatives, guests, and invitees.
 2. Assumption of Risk
 Exhibitor understands that participation in the Event involves inherent risks, including but not limited to property damage, personal injury, theft, fire, weather-related losses, and acts or omissions of third parties. Exhibitor voluntarily assumes all such risks, whether foreseeable or not, and warrants that they hold adequate insurance to cover any loss or injury to themselves, their property, or third parties arising out of their participation.
 3. Release and Waiver
 To the fullest extent permitted by law, Exhibitor irrevocably releases, waives, and discharges the Promoter and the Facility from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, losses, costs, or expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising out of or relating to Exhibitor's participation in or presence at the Event, regardless of cause or negligence, except in the case of the Promoter's or Facility's willful misconduct or gross negligence expressly established by a court of competent jurisdiction.
 4. Indemnification & Defense
 Exhibitor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Promoter and the Facility from and against any and all liability, loss, claims, demands, suits, actions, damages, fines, penalties, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of or resulting from:
 a) any act, omission, or negligence of Exhibitor;
 b) injury (including death) to any person or damage to any property in connection with Exhibitor's participation, display, products, or activities;
 c) Exhibitor's breach of any term of the Event registration, Facility rules, or applicable law.
 The duty to defend applies immediately upon written notice of any actual or threatened claim, regardless of the merits.
 5. Insurance Requirement
 Exhibitor shall maintain, at its own expense, comprehensive general liability insurance with limits of not less than US \$1,000,000 per occurrence and US \$2,000,000 aggregate (or equivalent), naming Powerama Customs and Greene County Expo Center & Fairgrounds as additional insureds. Proof of coverage must be produced upon request before occupancy of any space.
 6. No Subrogation
 Exhibitor waives any rights of subrogation against the Promoter and Facility and agrees that its insurers shall have no right of recovery against either party.
 7. Compliance & Governing Law
 Exhibitor agrees to comply with all federal, state, and local laws, Facility regulations, and directions of Event staff. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio, without regard to conflict-of-law rules. Exclusive jurisdiction and venue lie in the state or federal courts located in Greene County, Ohio.
 8. Severability
 If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
 9. Acknowledgment & Acceptance
 By signing or electronically submitting the Event registration, Exhibitor acknowledges that they have carefully read, understand, and voluntarily accept the terms of this Indemnification & Release of Liability and agree to be bound thereby.
